SMEI is excited to announce two new Core Specialists:

Helena Björelius: works as a SLPspecialist in Childhood Motor Speech
Disorders at the Oral Motor Centre, a
Speech Clinic at Danderyds Hospital, a
national health hospital in Stockholm,
Sweden. Her area of interest has been comorbidity of motor speech disorders and
fine and gross motor dysfunctions. She has
performed research in the area and has

published a peer reviewed article in the *International Journal of Speech-Language Pathology*.

Helena attended her first class of MNRI® in 2010, *Dynamic and Postural Reflex Integration* with Dr. Masgutova in Sweden and started her Core Specialist professional track in Poland in 2011. The work was introduced to her by her dear friend MNRI® Core Specialist and MNRI Instructor, Susanne Wolmesjö. As soon as Helena had her first certificate in her hand, she started to treat patients. She saw that the children developed not only their speech but also had great gains in other areas such as social abilities, communication, and motor skills and realized that this was the treatment she had been looking for. She is very happy to now have reached the MNRI® Core Specialist level.

Her next step in MNRI® is to study further to become an Instructor through the MNRI® Teacher Training Track. Her future goal is to become a certified Instructor of *Oral Facial Reflex Integration* classes, then the *Parent Class, Visual and Auditory Reflex Integration*, and also the *Breathing Reflexes* in order to help bring these classes to her country of Sweden.

She is also working toward a PhD and is planning a study using a single-case study design before and after MNRI® treatment on children with CAS and developmental dysarthria.

Helena says, "I want to thank Dr Masgutova and all the therapists around the world for developing this amazing intervention. This is the future."

Dr. Joan Spalding has been working with children, students, parents, and teachers all of her professional life. Her research for her doctoral degree from Colorado State University in 2005 included working with teachers and psychologists in Russia and America to test their students' and clients' ability to develop contralateral movement to focus on academics, behavioral differences, and physical changes in body perception.



After working with Dr. Masgutova in Russia at

Russia's Open University, she quickly became one of her first students when Svetlana came to the U.S. to teach Dynamic and Postural Reflexes at an International Brain Gym conference in Virginia in 2003. The emotional changes she experienced in the class regarding her own trauma led her to explore the concept of Reflex Integration on many levels.

In 2012, she became a Core-in-Training and, after taking many courses, is now a Core Specialist and will soon become an Instructor in the PTSD program. Since 2012, Dr. Spalding has participated in over 1200 hours of family conferences working with participants doing the Neuro-structural, Tactile, Breathing, and PTSD protocols.

Neurosensory motor dance

If you have worked or attended a conference with Dr. Masgutova, you may know that she sometimes starts the day leading this dance. It is an effective stress management tool and helps us integrate our reflexes!

Self-Initiated Exercises

(Switch on some dance music – slower or faster depending on your preference and ability).

Initial position: stand, sit, or lay down straight with your hands at your sides. You can do the movements saying the words in parentheses while you are dancing.

Movement 1: Step to the right side and bring your arms up flexed at the elbows as if opening the core of your body (say "I am open to the world!"). Then do the same movement to the left side as if opening the core (say "You are open to the world!"). Repeat twice.

Movement 2: Step forward and to the side a bit (for stability) with your right leg. Bring your right arm up, and your left arm down and backwards. ("I am a Winner!"). Next do the same movement with your left leg forward and your left arm up and your right arm down and backwards. ("You are a Winner!", "I live in the World of Winners!")

Repeat twice.





Movement 3: Do a wave movement with your right arm/hand to the left ("I live with a flow of life, I make the best choices, I focus well, memorize productively, and think quickly and positively!"). Knees will flex slightly in a



bouncing motion with movement of arm. Next do the same movement with your left arm/hand ("I am open for others to live with a flow of their life, to make good choices, focus well, memorize productively, and think quickly and positively!"). Repeat twice.

Movement 4: Standing with feet shoulder width apart, glide your right hand up and over your head (like combing your hair) from front to back. Next do the same movement with your left arm. Knees will flex slightly in a bouncing motion with the



movement of arm. ("I am so good! You are so good!", "I invite good people and good events into my life!").

Repeat twice.

Movement 5: Jump with left leg forward, while right leg lunges back. Extend your right arm up with a thumb up and left arm back and down. ("I am a winner! You are a winner!").

Repeat twice.



Movement 6: Lift right leg to hip level, cross over left foot and spin to back. Repeat once more so you are facing front again. Repeat the movement with left leg to spin in the left direction.



Repeat twice.
